THESIS STATEMENT 1: 'Do not hold on to me'. John 20:17 revisited.

John 20:17 is one of the most debated verse in the New Testament. Why Mary Magdalene is not permitted to touch or to hold the risen Jesus because he has not yet ascended to the Father? How to understand two affirmations of the risen Jesus in this verse: "I have not yet ascended to the Father" and "I am ascending to my Father..."? However, John 20:17, with its own characteristics, gives us a significant message in the whole Gospel.
